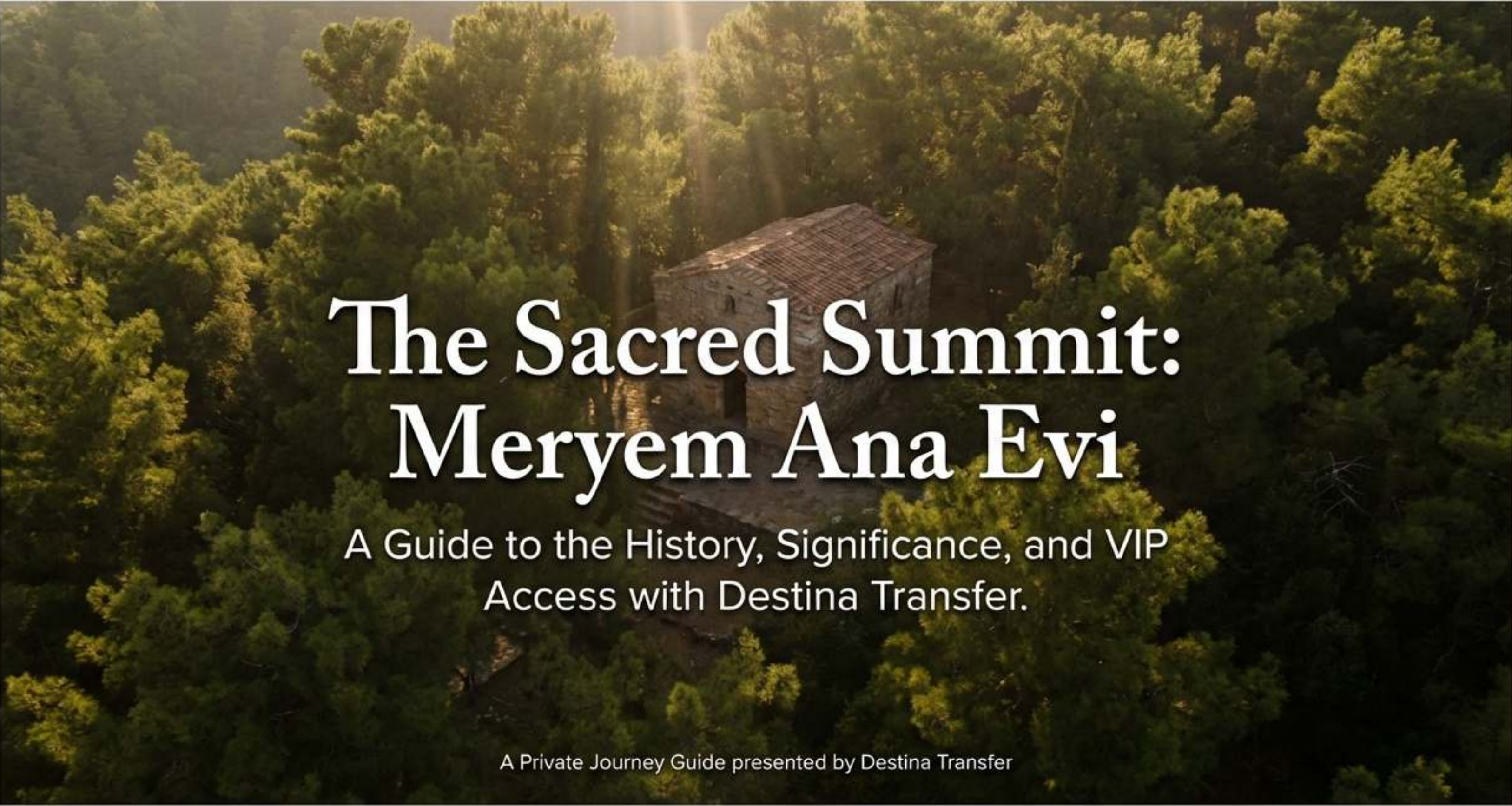

Sanctuary on Mount Nightingale

The Location

Perched on the summit of Bülbül Dağı, the site offers a retreat into nature, far removed from city noise and the bustle of the coast.

The Tradition

According to Christian belief, Jesus entrusted his mother to St. John the Apostle before the crucifixion. To ensure her safety, John brought Mary to Ephesus, hiding her in this remote mountain home for her final earthly days.

The Atmosphere

A Green Pause. The site is surrounded by dense pine forests, offering visitors not just a history lesson, but a deep sense of spiritual tranquility and silence.



Rediscovered Through Vision and Faith



The Vision

German nun Anna Katharina Emmerick has detailed visions of Mary's house in Ephesus, despite never visiting the region.



1881: First Contact

French priest Julien Gouyet uses Emmerick's descriptions to explore the mountain and discovers the first traces of ruins.



1891: Confirmation

A second expedition by Lazarist monks confirms the location matches the visions, sparking international interest.



1950s: Restoration

Restoration work begins under Vatican guidance, transforming the ruins into a pilgrimage site.

Interfaith Harmony

A rare sanctuary held sacred by both Christians and Muslims. The site is a symbol of peace and unity.

Key Event: The Feast of the Assumption of Mary is celebrated here every August 15th, drawing thousands of local and foreign visitors.

Inside the Sanctuary



The Chapel: A humble stone structure containing the statue of the Virgin Mary and a dedicated altar.



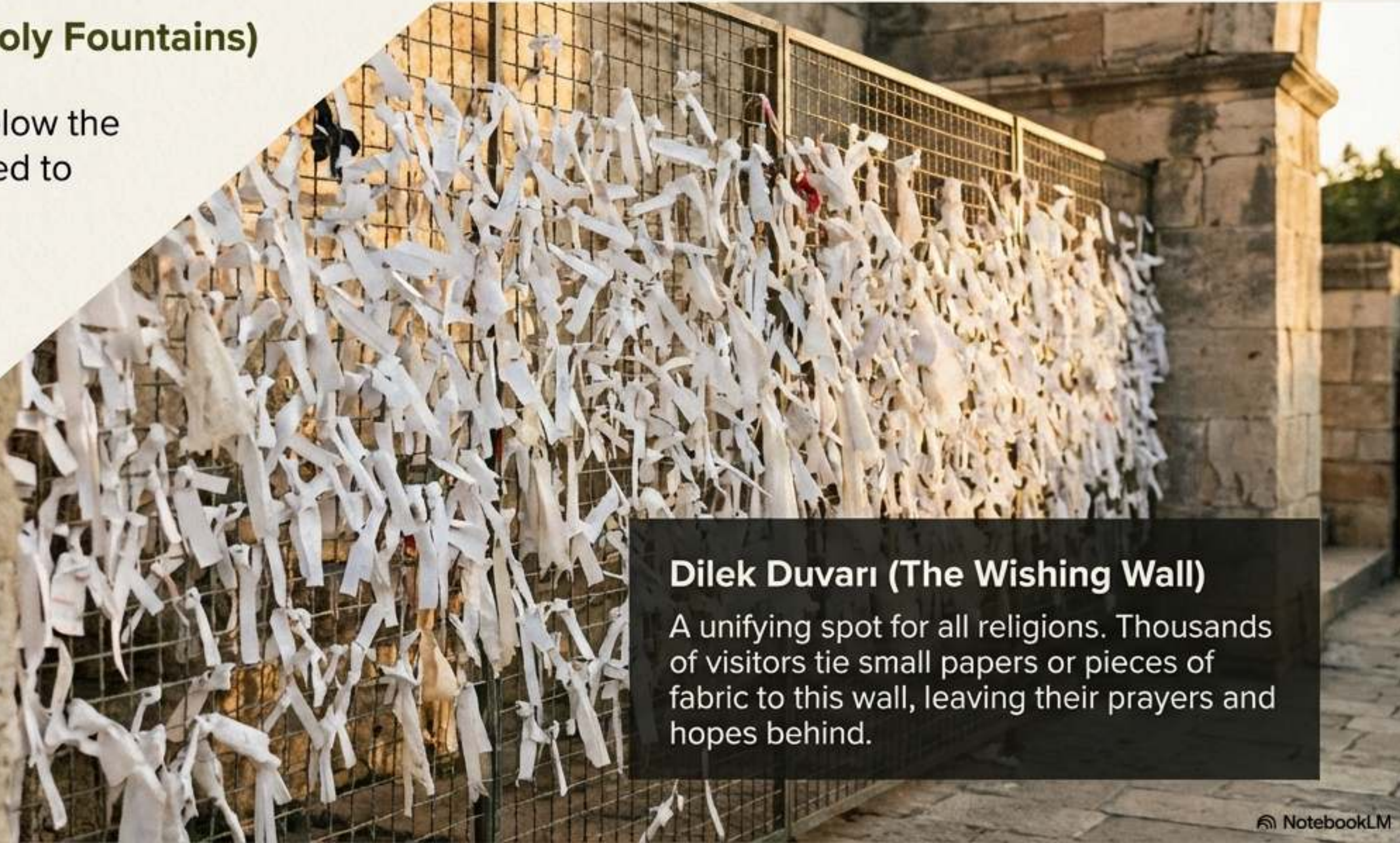
The Atmosphere: A zone of quiet reflection where visitors light candles and set intentions.

Silence is requested inside the chapel to preserve the prayerful atmosphere for all pilgrims.

The Waters of Healing and Hope

Kutsal Çeşmeler (The Holy Fountains)

Three fountains located below the house. The water is believed to have healing properties. Visitors are encouraged to drink or collect the water in small bottles.



Dilek Duvarı (The Wishing Wall)

A unifying spot for all religions. Thousands of visitors tie small papers or pieces of fabric to this wall, leaving their prayers and hopes behind.

Essential Visitor Etiquette & Rules



Dress Code

As a holy site, modest dress is required. Shoulders and knees must be covered.



Conduct

Silence is requested throughout the grounds to preserve the spiritual atmosphere.



Duration

Plan for approximately 1 hour to fully experience the atmosphere, visit the chapel, and pray.



Important Note on Tickets

The site is managed by a private foundation. The Museum Pass is NOT valid here; a separate entrance fee applies.

The Challenge of the Mountain



Remote Location

The House is located on the high peak of Bülbül Dağı, isolated from the main city center.



Limited Access

Public transportation to the summit is scarce and restricted.



The Friction

Relying on erratic shuttles or navigating steep mountain roads can add stress to what should be a peaceful journey. To maintain the spiritual mindset, the journey up the mountain requires reliability and comfort.
